What is a Data Breach?

A data breach is the loss, theft, accidental release or accidental publication of nonpublic personally identifiable information or protected health information.

Most Common Breach Scenarios

- ◆ Lost or stolen laptops and storage devices
- ◆ Accidental mailing/emailing to the wrong individual
- ◆ Improper document or office equipment disposal
- ◆ Unintended posting or sharing of sensitive data
- ◆ Breach caused by a third-party vendor
